## THE ARTISTS



### Steven Reineke conductor

*Steven Reineke made his TSO début in March 1997.*

Steven Reineke has established himself as one of North America’s leading conductors of popular music. Along with his role as Principal Pops Conductor of the TSO, this season, Mr. Reineke celebrates his tenth anniversary as Music Director of The New York Pops at Carnegie Hall. He is also Principal Pops Conductor of the National Symphony Orchestra at the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, and Principal Pops Conductor of the Houston Symphony Orchestra.

Reineke is a frequent guest conductor with The Philadelphia Orchestra, and his extensive North American conducting appearances include Atlanta, Cincinnati, Edmonton, San Francisco, and Sarasota. On stage, Reineke has created programs and collaborated with a range of leading artists from the worlds of hip-hop, Broadway, television, and rock, including Common, Kendrick Lamar, Nas, Sutton Foster, Megan Hilty, Cheyenne Jackson, Wayne Brady, Peter Frampton, and Ben Folds, among others. In 2017, National Public Radio’s *All Things Considered* featured Reineke leading the National Symphony Orchestra performing live music excerpts between news segments—a first in the show’s 45-year history. In 2018, Reineke led the National Symphony Orchestra with hip-hop legend Nas performing his seminal album *Illmatic* on PBS’s *Great Performances*.

As the creator of more than 100 orchestral arrangements for the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra, Reineke’s work has been performed worldwide and can be heard on numerous Cincinnati Pops

Orchestra recordings on the Telarc label. His symphonic works, *Celebration Fanfare*, *Legend of Sleepy Hollow*, and *Casey at the Bat*, are performed frequently. His *Sun Valley Festival Fanfare* was used to commemorate the Sun Valley Summer Symphony pavilion, and his *Festival Te Deum* and *Swan's Island Sojourn* were debuted by the Cincinnati Symphony and Cincinnati Pops. His numerous wind ensemble compositions are published by the C.L. Barnhouse Company and are performed by concert bands worldwide.



## **Betsy Wolfe** vocalist

*Betsy Wolfe made her TSO debut in February 2013.*

Betsy Wolfe starred in the Tony-nominated musical *Waitress* on Broadway. Other recent Broadway credits include Cordelia in the Broadway revival of *Falsettos*; *Bullets over Broadway*; *The Mystery of Edwin Drood*; *Everyday Rapture*; and *110 in the Shade*. She is perhaps best known for her critically acclaimed performance as Cathy in the Off-Broadway revival of *The Last Five Years*. Other favourite credits include the City Center Encores! production of *Merrily We Roll Along*; the La Jolla Playhouse world première production *Up Here*; ACT's world première of *Tales of the City*; and *Die Fledermaus* at the Metropolitan Opera. She has been a guest artist for over 50 symphony, pops, and philharmonic orchestras across the US and internationally, including the New York Philharmonic and Chicago Symphony Orchestra. She holds a BFA in musical theatre from the Cincinnati Conservatory of Music and is the Co-Founder of BroadwayEvolved, a groundbreaking summer intensive for theatre students and educators.
